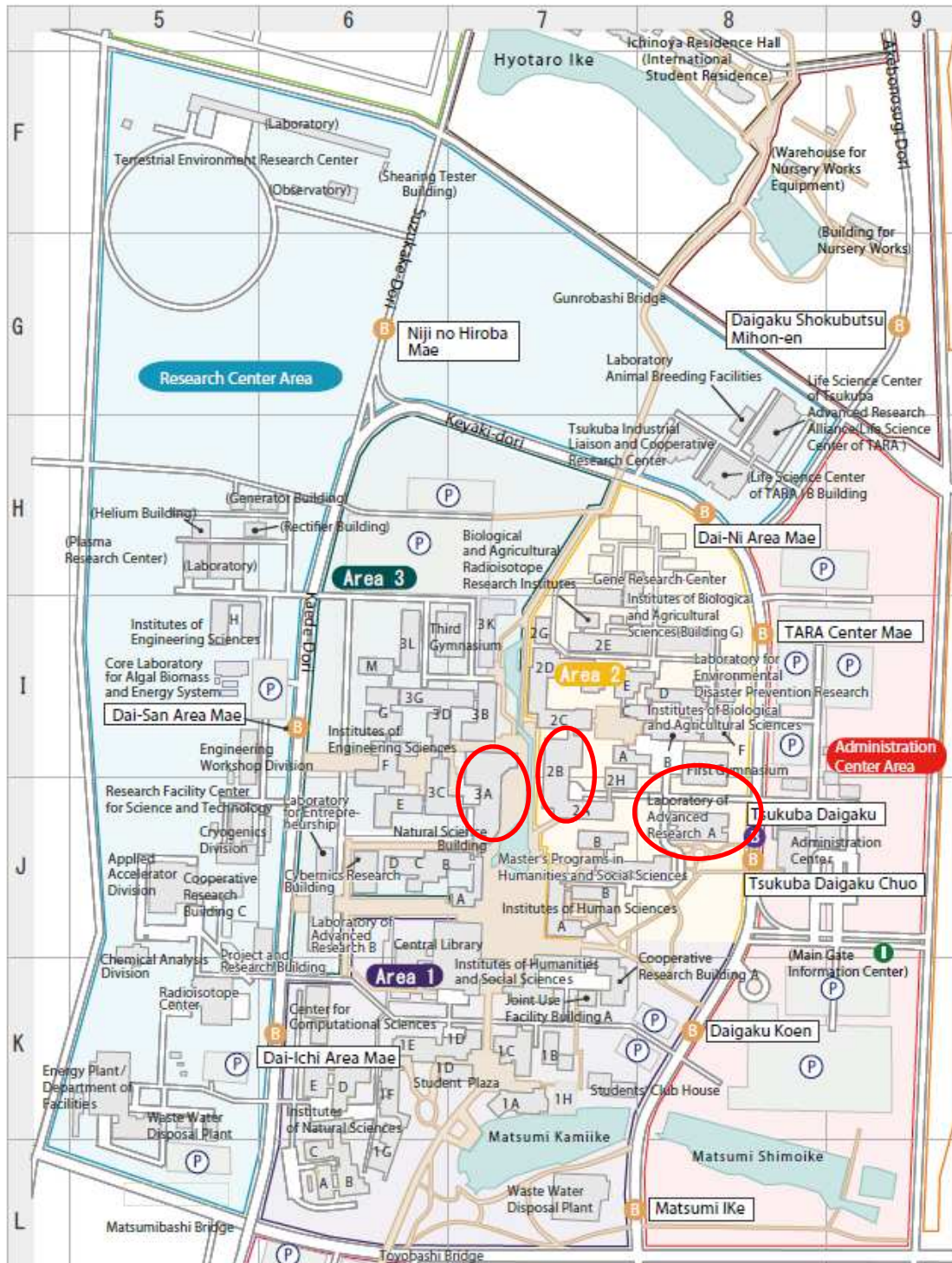

Tsukuba Express (TX) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">45 minutes from Akihabara Station to Tsukuba Station by rapid train. After getting off at Tsukuba Station (Exit A3), you can take a bus at the bus terminal Number 6. Timetable  Fares 
Highway Express Bus from Tokyo Station 	<ul style="list-style-type: none">About 75 minutes from Tokyo Station Yaesu South Exit by bus bound for "Tsukuba Daigaku"

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Highway Express Bus Stand No.2 Timetable • About 65 minutes from Tokyo Station Yaesu South Exit by bus bound for "Tsukuba Center" * See Access to the University of Tsukuba from Tsukuba Station.
<p>Airport bus</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Haneda Airport (To Tsukuba Center: Airport bus + bus) • Highway Bus Terminal Bus Timetable • About 120 minutes from Haneda Airport by bus bound for "Tsukuba Center". Take a bus at the bus stop No.6 in the International Terminal or at the bus stop No.13 in the Terminal 1 or 2.
<p>By car</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Driving directions from Joban Expressway • Access to the university by taking the Joban Expressway (the way to the Administration Center, the University of Tsukuba) • Drive to the Sakura Tsuchiura Interchange Exit, Turn left to Tsukuba Direction • → Turn right at Sasagi Intersection • → Drive further north on the Prefectural Highway 55 (Higashi Odori (East Avenue)) • → Turn left at the signal "Tsukuba Chuo Iriguchi (Main Entrance)" (about 8km) • Driving directions from Route 6 • Drive north on the Prefectural Highway 55 (Higashi Odori (East Avenue)) • → Go straight down Sasagi Intersection • → Turn left at the signal "Tsukuba Chuo Iriguchi (Main Entrance)" • Parking lot • See the map as follows. http://www.tsukuba.ac.jp/english/access/map_central.html • You can park your car at 3 north parking lots and 1 south parking lot in the Administration Center Area (Ⓟ on the campus map). The gates will be open on the day. (A parking permit is unnecessary.)
